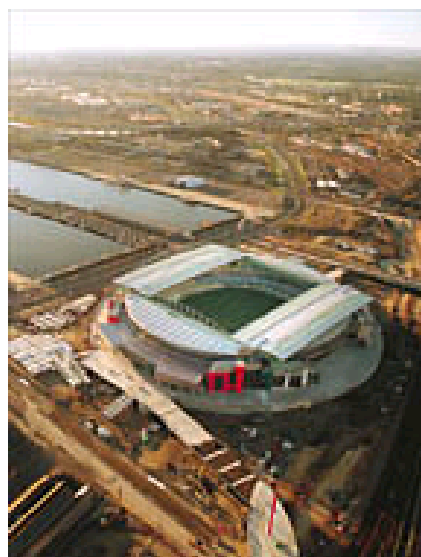
Daryl Jackson Architects implement QTRAK for project management.

Daryl Jackson are one of Australia's premier Architectural practices, based in Melbourne with offices in Sydney, Brisbane, London and Berlin.

Daryl Jackson Bligh Lobb were the Architects for the award winning Colonial Stadium, recently completed at the docklands precinct of Melbourne. With a 160m x 100m retractable roof that can be closed in 20 minutes, the venue is ideal for all weather conditions and has a seating capacity of approximately 50,000.



Boulderstone Horbiprook were the builder on this project and Connell Wagner provided a full range of engineering services. Both these companies use QTRAK for project correspondence management and hence this project was an ideal opportunity to implement QMAIL whereby the main project players could send and receive project correspondence electronically to and from each other.



Daryl Jackson Bligh Lobb were encouraged to purchase their own QTRAK License to enable them to participate.

While each party had their own installation of QTRAK, project correspondence such as Architect Instructions, Contact Advice Notes, and Project Managers instructions were sent electronically between the parties. This not only saved time on data entry but also, by speeding up communications, contributed to the timely resolution of requests for information - benefiting the project as a whole.

Importantly there were no data ownership issues as each party had their own database. Further more, since the form types to be used for communications were agreed up front, when electronic documents were received from each party they were uploaded intelligently into QTRAK.

Hence for example a response required by date on a Project Managers Instruction from Daryl Jackson Bligh Lobb would appear as an intelligent response required by value when uploaded by Baulderstone Hornibrook. This meant that as soon as the daily mail (or QMAIL) had been imported, items requiring responses could be immediately identified and actions assigned electronically to team members.

Following on from the successful use of QTRAK on the Colonial Stadium project, Daryl Jackson have implemented QTRAK in the Melbourne head office. Their latest large project, in conjunction with Sinclair Knight Merz and Lyons Pty Ltd is the Victorian County Court project.
